Grants in 2022 focused on mental health

by offering our neighbors care, compassion and a hospitality that meets them where they are and gives them what they need to heal themselves. A grant was given to support the renovation of a new therapy office and case manager's space on the second floor of the Reconciliation Services building at 31st and Troost (pictured left). Village Church's contribution will help Reconciliation Services double its capacity for providing therapy and social services in the community.

The Endowment Trust also provided funding for Kansas Missouri Mental Health Collaborative, Inc., a 501(c)3 incubated through the Village Church Pastoral Care and Counseling Department. The

Collaborative will provide high-quality, accessible and affordable mental health services to the Kansas City community by helping people access the support, guidance and resources they need at critical times in their lives. The Collaborative was able to hire its first executive director, Jennifer Wewers (pictured right), and is in the process of hiring a clinical director and therapists.



Music and Worship Legacy Fund enables special opportunities to express faith through music.



Facilities Legacy Fund helps to provide places where we can come together in prayer and celebration.

Seminar Legacy Fund assists with opportunities to learn, grow in faith and build a stronger relationship with God and one another. This grant supports the Meneilly Conference.
