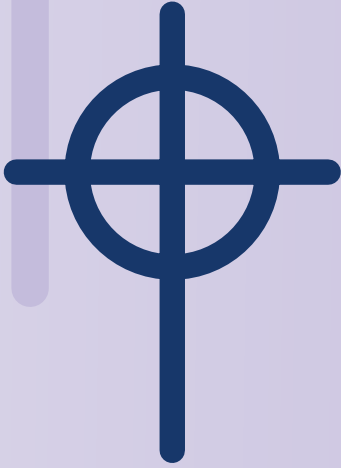


**Soar we now where Christ hath led, Alleluia!
