

IMMUNIZATIONS:

- ✚ Check CDC-recommended List: <https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/traveler/none/kenya>
 - Thwake Village Partnership is not trained in providing counsel regarding which immunizations you should or should not get. If you have questions or are under the care of a doctor, please schedule an appointment with your doctor to discuss:
 1. your plan of care for the trip
 2. non-required boosters and immunizations that you might need (ex. Tetanus, Pneumonia, Shingles)
 3. whether or not you should get the Yellow Fever vaccine. If your doctor recommends against it, please ask her or him to provide you with a doctor's note stating such.
